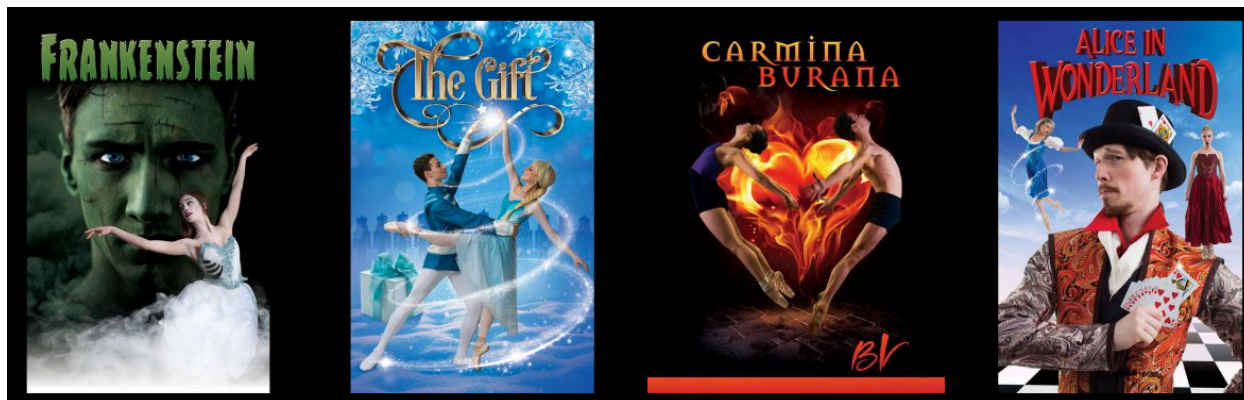
Welcome to Ballet Victoria's newest dancer, Tymin Keown!
