COVID-19 Protocols

Sanitation Procedures

- All chairs, washrooms, and public areas will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected every day before the arrival of guests.
- High touch zones such as doorknobs/handles and railings will be sanitized frequently for the safety of everyone.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be placed throughout Kirk Hall and the entrance.

Physical Distancing Protocols

- If you or anyone in your group is feeling sick or unwell, please stay home and do not attend the performance.
- BV will follow the maximum amount of audience members per performance as per the Health BC guidelines, currently set at 80 people per performance.
- All seating arrangements will be made by Ballet Victoria to ensure proper spacing for physical distancing.
- Please stay within your group and do not mingle with other guests.
- If you are meeting someone at the show, please arrive together.
- Please do not arrive more than 30 minutes prior to the performance.
- Bathroom capacity will be lowered to one person at a time to ensure proper physical distancing.
- Doors will be one way. One door to enter, one door to exit. PPE such as masks will follow BC Health recommendations. Masks will be mandatory at all times for audience members. BV asks that you come prepared to the venue with your own mask (BV will provide disposable masks to those without one).
- Audience members 12+ will need to be partially vaccinated for performances starting October 15, 2021 and *fully* vaccinated for performances after October 24, 2021. Audience members 12+ will be asked to present proof of vaccination and valid government ID. If an audience member does not have the required documents, they will not be permitted to enter the venue.
